4. Speaker's name, affiliation and credentials (a CV or short bio is requested)
5. Course description (maximum of 75-100 words)
6. Three learning objectives for this session
7. Length of session (hands-on workshops & breakouts normally last 60 minutes while a plenary session runs 30 minutes)
8. Skill level - whether the session is geared toward beginners, intermediate, advanced or all
